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1 Name

This instrument is the *National Medal (Approved Government Organisations) Determination 2019*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day it is published in the Gazette.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under regulation 4 of the *National Medal Regulations 2011*.

4 Schedules

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

5 Definitions

(1) In this instrument:

Regulations means the *National Medal Regulations 2011* set out in the Schedule to the Letters Patent dated 20 April 2011 given under the Great Seal of Australia.

table means the table in subsection 6(1).

(2) Unless the contrary intention appears, expressions used in this instrument have the same meaning as in the Regulations.

(1) For the purposes of regulation 4 of the Regulations, a government organisation specified in column 1 of an item of the table is an approved government organisation.
