GOVERNMENT POSITION

- The Government has given nbn a mandate to find the fastest and most cost-effective way to complete the network.
- nbn's trial of a variation of its fibre to the node product is not new.
- nbn announced that it has been trialling a possible solution using fibre to the pit at its half-year results presentation earlier this month.
- The latest technology being tested is a version of fibre to the node using smaller boxes of electronics which can be placed underground.
- The company published its audited half-year results earlier this month showing full fibre to the premise is continuing to cost on average \$4419 per premise.
- In some cases, the cost of connecting a premise this way can run
 into the tens of thousands of dollars, where there is a lot of civil
 work needed to get fibre all the way into the building.
- With the multi-technology mix, nbn has the flexibility to test variations of fibre to the node to lower the cost per premise.
- Fibre to the node which includes placing electronics in cabinets, or in pits, or in the basement of buildings – offers cost-effective solutions in a range of locations.
