

Grateful if you could continue to pass on any enquiries so that the AGO can respond directly with this statement. They have already responded to outstanding enquiries.

Statement from the Attorney-General:

"I am aware of the reports that Khaled Sharrouf has been killed.

"As has been previously stated, the Government's capacity to confirm reports of deaths in either Syria or Iraq is extremely limited - it is a war zone.

"But, if the reports are true, Australia will not mourn Khaled Sharrouf. He committed some of the most horrific crimes and waged war on Australians and our way of life.

"Khaled Sharrouf and his wife took their children to an active warzone, and exposed them to the barbaric practices of Islamic State.

"Australians will well remember the chilling images of Khaled Sharrouf encouraging his own children to hold aloft the severed heads of victims of ISIL. It is incomprehensible that any parent would behave in such a way.

"That is why we have consistently warned Australians that by becoming involved in conflicts overseas they are putting their own, and others, lives in danger. And if they manage to return, they will be subjected to the full extent of the law."
