

Tax Deductible Gift Recipient Reform Opportunities

Dear PM,

I'm writing to express my opposition to the recent "Tax Deductible Gift Recipient Reform Opportunities" Discussion Paper released by the Australian Treasury. I am particularly concerned about the proposal which would force environmental organisations to spend at least 25% of their funds on remediation work like planting trees and weed removal.

I make significant donations to the Climate Council and have done since it was established, which was necessitated by your predecessor's abolition of the Climate Commission. That decision was a national disgrace. I and many others could not allow the important work of the Commission to vanish so we put our own money into supporting an organisation that should, by any sensible test, be funded by the Commonwealth.

Your government has no right to direct where charities must spend their - my! - money. The Climate Council does extremely important work, but it is not an organisation with skills in remediation. Your government's attempt to force it to undertake certain activities for which it is not suited is simply a device to make it ever more difficult for it and other environmental organisations to function in this country. Ultimately, it is yet another example of the Coalition's unwillingness to stand up to the fossil fuel industry and do what is right for the future of the world and of Australia.

These proposals are an attack on Australian democracy and science. You know better than this, Prime Minister - for once, stand up to the lunatic right of your party and you may finally garner some respect from an electorate that expected so much better from you.
