

## 2018-19 Budget at a glance: Impacts on sectors and regions

**Great Barrier** Reef Funding Injection

The measure provides \$443.8 million to the Great Barrier Reef Foundation to deliver water quality improvements, Crown-of-Thorns Starfish control, science innovation for Reef restoration and adaptation, Reef health monitoring and reporting, and Traditional Owner engagement. It also provides a funding boost to the Joint Field Management Program.

These proposals will generate employment opportunities and economic stimulus for Queensland communities, through collaboration with local tourism, research and ranger groups, including Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Australians.

## QUESTION TIME BRIEF (QTB) GREAT BARRIER REEF

**QUESTION:** What is the Government doing to protect the Great Barrier Reef?

### **KEY POINTS:**

- Everything that we do as a government is about backing hard working Australian families and businesses, including those in tourism. That is why my Government is making the single largest investment ever to ensure the resilience of the Great Barrier Reef in the face of climate change and other threats.
- The Great Barrier Reef is one of Australia's most iconic natural assets, supporting 64,000 jobs and adding \$6.4 billion value to the economy each year. Investing in the Reef is investing in the regional and national economy.
- Like reefs all over the world, the Great Barrier Reef is under pressure. A big challenge demands a big investment.
- My Government's game-changing \$500 million investment shows we are serious about tackling these challenges and ensuring Australians and visitors from around the world can continue to enjoy the wonders of the Reef into the future.
- An important feature of this investment is our partnership with the Great Barrier Reef Foundation, which will aim to leverage additional investment from private investors and philanthropists.
- These investments will put the Reef in the best position to regenerate and remain resilient in the face of multiple threats. The package includes:
  - \$200 million to address water quality by improving farming practices, improved fertiliser use and uptake of new technology and land management practices.
  - \$100 million to harness the best science in reef restoration and adaption.
  - o \$58 million to expand efforts to control crown-of-thorns-starfish.
  - \$42 million over six years and \$10.2 million each year ongoing for the world-class Queensland and Australian Government Joint Field Management Program.

- \$40 million to improve Reef health monitoring and reporting.
- \$22 million to engage communities and Traditional Owners in reef protection.
- Together the Commonwealth and Queensland governments have committed to invest more than \$2 billion in the Reef over a decade.

## If asked: Why is the Government partnering with the Great Barrier Reef Foundation?

- The Foundation was established in 2000 and has a strong track record of working with diverse range of Reef stakeholders and delivering on-ground benefits to the Reef. The Foundation actively and publicly supports our Reef 2050 Plan.
- The Foundation has experience managing a diverse range of Reef projects, including saving endangered green turtles and restoring damaged reef ecosystems. They are strongly focused on investing in science to help corals adapt to a changing climate.
- The Foundation has a robust corporate and financial governance framework, overseen by a board that includes current and former CEOs, Chairs and executive officers of some of Australia's largest companies.
- The Foundation has a successful fundraising record, generating around \$80 million from private and philanthropic sources for the Reef. Partnering with the Foundation provides an opportunity to leverage co-funding from non-government sources to complement the Government's investment.
- The Partnership will build on, and complement, existing efforts to implement the Reef 2050 Plan.


## If asked: The Reef is dying, what's the point in spending more money on it?

- The outlook for the Reef is troubling, but far from hopeless. Many reefs remain largely unaffected by bleaching.
- This partnership will deliver real actions we can put in place now to reduce pressures and give the Reef a chance to regenerate.

- We know reefs have the capacity to regenerate. For example, in the three years prior to the 2016 bleaching event and Cyclone Debbie, coral cover increased by 19 per cent across the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park.
- We need to maximise the capacity of the Reef to survive major climate-related events like coral bleaching, while efforts to reduce global climate change are underway.
- The Reef is a critical national asset. It protects Queensland's coastal infrastructure, supports 64,000 jobs and provides \$6.4 billion a year to the economy. A funding boost to the Reef is a boost to the regional and national economy.

### **BACKGROUND:**

On 29 April, Minister Bishop and Minister Frydenberg announce a major injection of almost \$500 million in new funding for the Great Barrier Reef. This includes:

- \$200 million to address water quality by improving farming practices, improved fertiliser use and uptake of new technology and land management practices.
- \$100 million to harness the best science in reef restoration and adaption.
- \$58 million to expand efforts to control crown-of-thorns-starfish.
- \$42 million over six years and \$10.2 million each year ongoing for the world-class Queensland and Australian Government Joint Field Management Program.
- \$40 million to improve Reef health monitoring and reporting.
- \$22 million to engage communities and Traditional Owners in reef protection.

The announcement substantially expands on the \$60 million Reef funding package you announced in January 2018 as part of a staged approach to tackle the pressures facing the Great Barrier Reef. This package included:

• \$6 million for the Australian Institute of Marine Science and the CSIRO to scope and design a major R&D program for coral reef adaptation and restoration over the next 18 months, including looking at how best to leverage private investment.

- \$10.4 million for an all-out assault on coral-eating crown-of-thorns starfish. This will allow the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority to increase the number of vessels targeting starfish from three to eight.
- \$36.6 million to further reduce pollution from water entering the Reef. This builds on our success with farmers reducing soil erosion, improving on-farm nutrient management and restoring coastal and riparian vegetation in the Reef catchments.
- \$4.9 million for more field officers on the water, improving compliance, and providing early warning of further bleaching and delivering more reef and island management interventions.

Deloitte Access Economics (2017) valued the Great Barrier Reef as having an economic, social and icon asset value of \$56 billion. It supports 64,000 jobs (direct and indirect employment based on 2015-16 year) and contributes \$6.4 billion to the Australian economy (in terms of value added GDP).

The \$56 billion asset value comprises Australian tourist visits (\$29 billion); value to those that haven't yet visited the Reef (\$24 billion); and value derived by Australian recreational users of the Reef (\$3 billion).

## If asked about The Australian's claim there will be over \$400 million for a Reef Rescue \_ackage in the Budget?

- My Government is committed to looking after the Great Barrier Reef as demonstrated by our actions and investments so far.
- I am not going to comment on speculation about the Budget.

### **BACKGROUND:**

On 27 April, the Australian published an article foreshadowing a more than \$400 million rescue package for the Great Barrier Reef. Further funding for the Reef has not been officially announced yet, but will be in this range. The major feature of the new funding is that it will be delivered through the Great Barrier Reef Foundation, this aspect of the proposal is not public yet.

Please see attached FYI. Overall a good news story. A few key things to note:

- Likely to be an announcement soon. The date in the brief has since changed I believe swill come in over the top if I'm wrong) and they are now looking at Friday 4-Saturday 5 May or thereabouts. This may move again though, will keep you posted. We are already doing prep-work on the announcement and will raise with S 22(1) tomorrow.
- I'm pretty happy with where the collaboration principles have landed. They take a strong stand on managing ramp-up risk (particularly expertise, governance, fraud control and WHS) and this will flow through into the grant agreement itself.
- The principles also have a strong focus on linking the Foundation's activities to the Reef 2050 apparatus, existing reporting mechanisms and flag a strong role for DEE and GBRMPA to assist with capacity building and delivery.

We will leave any other MP invitations to you.
- 6. We'll arrange for the **web team** to load all the comms material on Saturday morning. We can follow up with social media on the key themes of the announcement next week.
- 7. The **draft media release** is with S who was going to revise the lead to say 'almost a billion dollars', in line with the brochure text. Joint with Minister Price?
