- A \$7 billion global engineering company headquartered in Australia that provides project delivery and consulting services to the resources and energy sectors, and complex process industries.
 - o Worley claims it is "Australia's largest exporter of knowledge-based services" and says its key purpose is to deliver a more sustainable world.
