



Discussion followed on the appropriate course of action. After discussion, Decision No 2730 was taken.

That the Commission pursuant to Section 7 of the *Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission Act 1989*

- (a) **AGREED** to the attached in-principle resolution of the Strategic Directions Board Committee of 11 April 2003;
- (b) AGREED that the Board would make a further decision on the matter at its next meeting in June, following wide consultation with Regional Council Chairs and consideration of the paper to be released by the ATSIC Review Team next month; and
- (c) AGREED that the Chairman would convey this position to the Minister for Immigration and Multicultural and Indigenous Affairs.

The Chairman closed the meeting and thanked Commissioners for their attendance and participation in the discussion.

STRATEGIC DIRECTIONS BOARD COMMITTEE Resolution of Friday 11 April 2003

GOOD GOVERNANCE AND "SEPARATION OF POWERS"

The Committee:

- (a) **NOTED** the Chairman's report-back on his meeting with the Minister for Indigenous Affairs on 7 April 2003 (circulated to the Board on 8 April 2003);
- (b) **NOTED** the outcome of consultations with a sample group of Regional Council Chairs on 10 April 2003 regarding their views on 'separation of powers' in the context of the improved governance of ATSIC and Regional Councils;
- (b) **NOTED** that if the Board is to influence the Government's approach to 'separation of powers' within ATSIC, it needed to convey its final position to the Minister before Tuesday 15 April 2003;
- (c) **AGREED** to recommend to the Board that it supplement Board Decision No 2725 of 2 April by endorsing the development and implementation of an *ATSIC Governance Framework* that embodied the 'separation of powers' principle. Such a Framework would involve:
 - (i) the Government continuing to appropriate funds to ATSIC, subject to the current quarantines and general guidance specified by the Minister for Indigenous Affairs;
 - (ii) the Board setting policies, priorities and program guidelines supplemented, where appropriate, by priorities and guidance set by Regional Councils in the context of their Regional Plans;
 - (iii) delegations for individual funding decisions being exercised solely by the ATSIC Administration in line with the policies, priorities and guidelines referred to in (ii) above;
 - (iv) effective checks and balances to support open and merit-based decision-making by the Administration, including fair review mechanisms (both internal and external); and
 - (v) if the separation of powers principle is implemented as part of the Framework, the Minister for Indigenous Affairs be asked to rescind his Conflict of Interest Directions;
- (d) AGREED that under the proposed Governance Framework, the Board and Regional Councils would exercise a more strategic role. That role would be supported if the Board negotiated a framework with the Minister for Indigenous Affairs whereby Commonwealth agencies responsible for Indigenous-specific programs would use the Board and, where appropriate, Regional Councils as a focal point for consultations with Indigenous representatives on the framing of their policies and

- program interventions to Indigenous clients, thereby facilitating a shared responsibility for achieving more effective outcomes;
- (e) AGREED that a draft Governance Framework be developed as a matter of urgency by the Administration, in consultation with the Strategic Directions Board Committee, for consideration by the ATSIC Board and Regional Council Chairs in the near future;
- (f) AGREED that, subject to the decision of the Board, an effective communications strategy be developed to explain the implications of a *Governance Framework* (including the separation of powers principle) to Regional Councils, the ATSIC Administration, ATSIC-funded organisations and other stakeholders;
- (g) AGREED that the terms of this resolution be urgently considered by an extraordinary meeting of the Board, with the Board's position conveyed directly by the Chairman to the Minister for Indigenous Affairs before 15 April 2003; and
- (h) **AGREED** that this was an in-principle position to be pursued in the context of the outcome of the ATSIC Review, which is keenly awaited.
