i Attorney-General's (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal No. , 2013 Regulation 2013

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Attorney-General's (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2013*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Authority

This regulation is made under the *Legislative Instruments Act* 2003.

4 Guide to this regulation

This regulation repeals legislative instruments that are spent or no longer required, as authorised by section 48E of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003*.

To assist the reader, the instruments repealed by this regulation are listed in 4 Schedules.

Schedule 1 deals with solely amending and repealing instruments.

Schedule 2 deals with commencement instruments.

Schedule 3 deals with amending and repealing instruments that contain application, saving or transitional provisions.

Schedule 4 deals with other instruments that are spent or no longer required.

This regulation contains saving provisions that apply to the repeals, in addition to the provision made by section 7 of the *Acts*

Section 5

Interpretation Act 1901. That section applies to this regulation because of section 13 of the Legislative Instruments Act 2003.

5 Repeal of amending and repealing instruments

- (1) Each instrument mentioned in Schedule 1 is repealed.
- (2) The repeal of an instrument by this section does not affect any amendment or repeal (however described) made by the instrument.
- (3) Subsection (2) does not limit the effect of section 7 of the Acts Interpretation Act 1901 as it applies to the repeal of an instrument by this section.

6 Repeal of commencement instruments

- (1) Each instrument mentioned in Schedule 2 is repealed.
- (2) The repeal of an instrument by this section does not affect any commencement provided by the instrument.
- (3) Subsection (2) does not limit the effect of section 7 of the Acts Interpretation Act 1901 as it applies to the repeal of an instrument by this section.

7 Repeal of amending and repealing instruments containing other provisions

- (1) Each instrument mentioned in Schedule 3 is repealed.
- (2) The repeal of an instrument by this section does not affect:
 - (a) any amendment or repeal (however described) made by the instrument; or
 - (b) the continuing operation of any provision of the instrument made or expressed to be made for an application, saving or transitional purpose (or that makes provision consequential or related to such a provision).

Section 8

(3) Subsection (2) does not limit the effect of section 7 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* as it applies to the repeal of an instrument by this section.

8 Repeal of other redundant instruments

- (1) Each instrument mentioned in Schedule 4 is repealed.
- (2) The repeal of an instrument by this section does not affect:
 - (a) any amendment or repeal (however described) made by the instrument; or
 - (b) the continuing operation of any provision of the instrument made or expressed to be made for an application, saving or transitional purpose (or that makes provision consequential or related to such a provision).
- (3) Subsection (2) does not limit the effect of section 7 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* as it applies to the repeal of an instrument by this section.

9 Expiry of regulation

This regulation expires on the day after it commences, as if it had been repealed by another regulation.

Schedule 1—Repeal of amending and repealing instruments

Guide to this Schedule

This Schedule repeals amending and repealing legislative instruments that are spent, and that would have been repealed automatically under section 48A of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003* if they had been made after the commencement of that section. This Schedule does not include instruments with an application, saving or transitional provision: see Schedule 3.

The repeal of an instrument by this Schedule does not affect any amendment or repeal made by the instrument: see subsection 5(2).

Attorney-General's (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal

Regulation 2013

Under section 62 of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003* (the LIA), the Governor-General may make regulations prescribing all matters required or permitted by the LIA to be prescribed, or necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to the LIA.

Under subsection 48E(1) of the LIA, regulations made under the LIA may repeal a legislative instrument or provision of a legislative instrument.

Before the Governor-General makes a regulation for the purposes of subsection 48E(1) of the LIA, subsection 48E(2) of the LIA requires that the Attorney-General must be satisfied that the legislative instrument or provision to be repealed by the regulation is spent or is no longer required.

The proposed Regulation would repeal 1 005 legislative instruments administered by the Attorney-General that are spent or redundant. Schedule 1 would repeal solely amending and repealing instruments. Schedule 2 would repeal commencement instruments. Schedule 3 would repeal amending and repealing instruments that contain application, saving or transitional provisions. Schedule 4 would repeal any other instruments that are no longer required.

The purpose of the proposed Regulation is to 'tidy up' the Federal Register of Legislative Instruments (the FRLI). The instruments that would be repealed by the proposed Regulation have no ongoing legal effect or are no longer required. It is unnecessary for these instruments to remain on the FRLI.

The proposed Regulation will not undo anything done by the instruments to be repealed and will not impact on existing rights and duties.

The express power to make the proposed Regulation was inserted into the LIA by the Legislative Instruments Amendment (Sunsetting Measures) Act 2012 on 23 September 2012. The power permits bulk repeal of spent and redundant legislative instruments by regulation. The power was inserted into the LIA in response to recommendation 14 of the 2008 Review of the LIA and the finding of Department of Finance and Deregulation's Review of pre-2008 Commonwealth subordinate legislation and other regulation that a large number of legislative instruments on the FRLI are probably spent or redundant.

The instruments that would be repealed by the proposed Regulation would remain accessible by navigating to the historical section of the Comlaw website.

Under subsection 48E(1) of the LIA, regulations made under the LIA may repeal a legislative instrument or provision of a legislative instrument. Before the Governor-General makes a Regulation for the purposes of subsection 48E(1) of the LIA, subsection 48E(2) of the LIA requires that the Attorney-General must be satisfied that the legislative instrument or provision to be repealed by the Regulation is spent or is no longer required.

The Civil Aviation (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2014 would repeal 3327 legislative instruments administered by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority that are spent or redundant.

The Defence (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2014 would repeal 1103 legislative instruments administered by the Department of Defence that are spent or redundant.

The Education (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2014 would repeal 61 legislative instruments administered by the Department of Education that are spent or redundant.

The Employment (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2014 would repeal 118 legislative instruments administered by the Department of Employment that are spent or redundant.

The Environment (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2014 would repeal 866 legislative instruments administered by the Department of the Environment that are spent or redundant.

The Finance (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2014 would repeal 1168 legislative instruments administered by the Department of Finance that are spent or redundant.

The Foreign Affairs and Trade (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2014 would repeal 156 legislative instruments administered by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade that are spent or redundant.

The Immigration and Border Protection (Spent and Redundant Instruments) Repeal Regulation 2014 would repeal 270 legislative instruments administered by the Department of Immigration and Border Protection that are spent or redundant.
