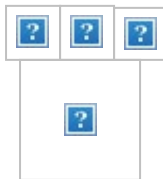

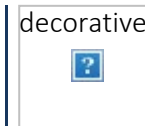

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Meeting with OpenAI

Deputy Secretary meeting brief

Purpose	Discuss OpenAI's plans for potential AI collaboration with Australia

Key Objectives

- Discuss OpenAI's vision for AI collaboration with Australia under its *OpenAI for Countries* initiative;
- Seek insights into OpenAI's other early engagements across the Asia-Pacific region.

Sensitivities

- Mr Kwon may characterise Australia's proposed mandatory guardrails for AI in high-risk settings as a potential barrier to investment. OpenAI has strongly supported the US Administration's deregulatory AI agenda and publicly criticised the European Union's AI Act.
- As part of its pitch for *OpenAI for Countries* (see [background](#)), OpenAI may seek Australia's co-investment in US-based infrastructure and press Australia to walk back certain proposed and existing regulatory settings, including on copyright, privacy law and accountability.

Discussion

You may wish to:

- Invite Mr Kwon to outline OpenAI's plans to collaborate with international partners, including its new *OpenAI for Countries* initiative, through which it is seeking to formalise infrastructure collaborations with other countries;
- Ask Mr Kwon to share insights from his Asia-Pacific engagements during this trip;
- Note the Australian Government is currently developing a National AI Capability Plan to explore ways to grow an innovative AI ecosystem and boost AI investment in Australia, including identifying enabling infrastructure requirements.
- *If asked about Australia's approach to AI regulation*:
 - Note that Australia is focused on seizing the opportunities presented by AI, including by lifting productivity across the economy, while building public trust through a risk-based approach.

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Background

OpenAI is a leading American AI research lab. Founded in 2015 by a consortium of tech researchers and entrepreneurs, including Elon Musk and Sam Altman, its mission is to achieve 'safe and beneficial' Artificial General Intelligence (AGI) – a stage of AI development with human-like capabilities. OpenAI has spawned several for-profit subsidiaries, including OpenAI Global LLC, which commercially licenses its technologies. The release of its ChatGPT in late 2022 – an advanced AI chatbot – precipitated the mainstream spread of generative AI. OpenAI has come under criticism for turning to a for-profit model, including by relaxing certain safety testing protocols and disbanding internal safety teams.

Previous engagement

- OpenAI has previously met with DISR officials to discuss *OpenAI for Countries*. It was not involved in earlier ministerial consultations on the National AI Capability Plan, held before the election.
- Mr Kwon is OpenAI's most senior representative to meet with Australian officials to date.

Stargate Project

- OpenAI's joint venture with SoftBank, Oracle and Emirati firm MGX was announced in January by President Trump. It plans to invest up to US\$500b in US-based AI infrastructure by 2029.

OpenAI for Countries

- Released in May 2025, OpenAI's new global export initiative aims to expand its US-based, Stargate supercomputing project through formal infrastructure partnerships between OpenAI, the US Government, and foreign governments. Up to 10 international projects will include deals to:
 - Support local AI start-up funds and data centre buildout for frontier-scale compute capacity;
 - Provide customised ChatGPT models to each country's residents;
 - Cooperate on educational initiatives and cyber and physical security controls for AI models;
 - Seek commitments from each country to invest in Stargate's growth in the United States.
- OpenAI claims it has received interest from over 30 countries. Media reports suggest that Mr Kwon will also be visiting Japan, South Korea, India and Singapore during this Asia-Pacific trip.
 - On 22 May, OpenAI announced its first Stargate partnership with the United Arab Emirates, with free ChatGPT Plus subscriptions for all UAE residents. A first US\$20b project with Nvidia, Oracle, Cisco and Emirati-based G42 will build a 200Mw AI data centre 'cluster' by 2026. As part of this deal, the UAE will match its domestic investment in the project dollar-for-dollar with investments in OpenAI's US-based AI infrastructure buildout.
 - On 26 May, Mr Kwon announced OpenAI would open an office in South Korea, which represents OpenAI's second-largest paid subscriber base after the United States.

OpenAI's Economic Blueprint and submission to the US AI Action Plan

- OpenAI's Economic Blueprint (Jan 2025) and submission to the White House's AI Action Plan (March 2025) include key 'freedom-focused policy proposals' to promote 'democratic AI':
 - Removing regulatory barriers to AI, placing liability on AI users instead of developers;
 - Ensuring global copyright settings allow AI firms to use data inputs without legal penalties;
 - Allowing AI firms to train on US government and other public data for commercial use;
 - Maximising AI infrastructure growth, including through a US export control strategy that allows partner nations access to critical AI inputs, contingent on shared standards.

Jason Kwon is Chief Strategy Officer at OpenAI. Previously, he served as General Counsel at Y Combinator Continuity, Assistant General Counsel at Khosla Ventures and an Associate Attorney at Goodwin. He was a software engineer and product manager before practising law.

Mr Kwon has a JD from UC Berkeley and a BA from Georgetown University.

**Oliver Jay – *Managing Director, International, OpenAI***

Oliver Jay has served as OpenAI's Managing Director for international strategy and operations since 2024. He was previously Chief Revenue Officer for Asana and as Dropbox's Head of Asia Pacific and Latin America.

Mr Jay has an MBA from Harvard Business School and a Bachelor's degree from the University of Pennsylvania.

**Sandy Kunvatanagarn – *Head of Policy, Asia Pacific, OpenAI***
