

The role of Secretary at the Department of Home Affairs has been vacant since the termination of Mr Michael Pezzullo AO on 27 November 2023. Acting arrangements have been in place since Mr Pezzullo stood aside on 25 September 2023.

Regardless of the recruitment option, under subsection 58(7) of the Act, I, as the Secretary of the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C), must provide a report to you regarding the appointment of a person as secretary. This must occur prior to you recommending the appointment of a person as secretary to the Governor-General. The report must be prepared following consultation with the Australian Public Service Commissioner and the relevant portfolio minister, in this case, the Minister for Home Affairs, the Hon Clare O'Neil MP.

- 6. While Secretary appointments are significant, there is no obligation for you to recommend an appointment to the Cabinet before seeking the Governor-General's agreement. However, we will provide you with the necessary support should you wish to take a proposed candidate to the Cabinet for consideration.
- 7. Once a preferred candidate is agreed, the appointment must be approved by the Governor-General at a meeting of the Federal Executive Council (ExCo).
 - a. The remaining meetings of ExCo in 2023 are scheduled for 7 and 14 December. It is anticipated that the first meeting of ExCo in 2024 will be in late January.


